



Does it ever snow in the Land of Jesus?

Yes, it snows in some parts of the land during the wet months of December, January, and February.

It may snow in the mountains, especially on the highest peaks of Mount Hermon and the Lebanon mountains. The snow here lasts a long time. Even in the hottest months, you can see that there is still snow on the very top of the mountain. If you visited the highest parts of the mountain, then you might find a snow field. Here you could slide or make a snow man or throw a snow ball.

For much of the time in the wet months of the year, there is snow on the high Eastern Plateau. The winds are icy cold when they blow across the snow into the hills and valleys on the west side of the Jordan River.

Once in a while it even snows down in the hills and valleys of Israel. It might snow even at Bethlehem. But this snow would last for only a day. It would soon melt away.
