



The men of Israel sometimes hunted for small wild fowl. They ate the meat of the fowl. If you want to know how the men hunted these birds, look at these Research Cards -

The quail was one of these wild fowl sometimes hunted. The quail is smaller than the partridge. The quail have trouble flying long distances. Usually they fly at night. Sometimes in the morning they are very tired. They can be caught easily by hand.

TURN CARD OVER



Two times God sent quail to the people of Israel to eat. God controls the birds. He can send them to His hungry people:

1. The people of Israel were going from Egypt to Canaan. They were travelling in the wilderness. There were rocks and sand. But there was little food. God sent quail to the people so they would have meat to eat. (Read it in Exodus 16:12-13)
2. Again the people were hungry. God said He would give them meat to eat. Moses wondered how God could send the meat. He said something like this -

There are 600,000 men. Shall all the sheep and oxen be killed? Or should all the fish of the sea be caught?

God told Moses that the meat would come just as He promised. He would keep His promise. The meat would come. He was able to do this.

God brought quail to the camp. Again the people of Israel ate meat! (You can read this in Numbers 11:31)
