

The white stork travels through the land of Israel. Some of them stay in the land for a little time.

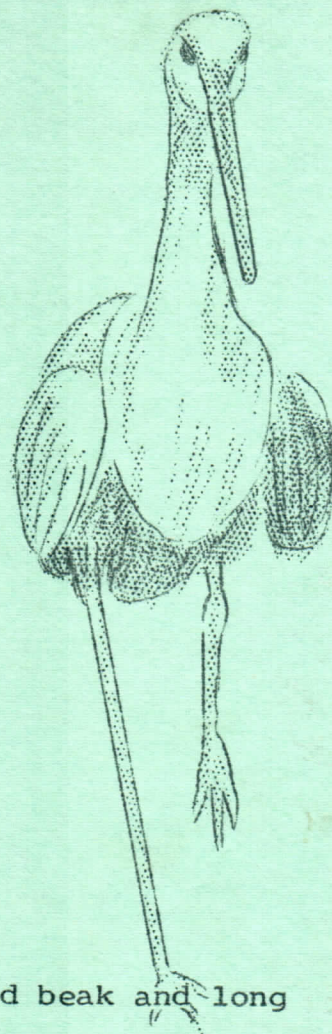
The stork comes faithfully every year. You could depend on this big bird to arrive on time.
